It's been a year of breaking winning runs for Port Adelaide in 2004. The Bombers were able to snap a 6 game losing streak against Port a few weeks back, and Adelaide was able to break a 7 game losing streak against Port back in round 7. Their win against Port this year returned the biggest StatRating™ that Adelaide has registered since 2000. It was also the first time they had kicked a score over 100 in the past 5 years, and a possession per score of 8.3 was the first under the 10 mark. Quite an effort from the Crows and all eyes will be focused on the game this week to see if they can reproduce that form again. With no finals campaign to look forward to in 2004, Port Adelaide has been posted favourite in this match, as a top 2 spot beckons should they beat Adelaide here.

The Crows have recovered well from the annihilating loss at the hands of Brisbane 5 weeks back. Since then, they have a 3-1 record, and have a chance to end an otherwise disappointing year on a high note. Considering their high StatRating™ and StatRating™ Margin against the Tigers, they could have been excused for losing last weeks game, but they didn't. It was another 600+ StatRating™ and a good effort. It was also helped by the fact that Geelong was coming in with a StatRating™ Margin of 446, and also ready to fall. This consecutive 600+ StatRating™, and a P/S of fewer than 10 is always difficult to maintain for sides outside the Top 8. The Crows have certainly been at these levels before in 2004, and the table below highlights their performance in the following week when playing at these levels.

The figures highlighted in light blue represent current playing criteria, while the figures in red show the game result in the following week, and the cells highlighted in Green indicate the Crows StatRating™ in the following week. The bottom figures show the Crows latest form. As expected, it's difficult to maintain these figures in consecutive weeks. Rounds 2,7, and 10 all resulted losses in the following weeks, while rounds 13 and 14 resulted in a loss in round 15. There was much speculation at that time as Neil Craig had just taken over as coach, but the Dees where also ready to come down from 3 wins, and their form at AAMI Stadium is well documented. Those 2 games are a good reference point in regards to the last 2 weeks. Both had 600+ StatRating™ figures, as well as a Possession per score below 10 in successive weeks. The only difference we need to careful of is the high StatRating™ Margin was not present with the Crows last week, as it has been on other occasions. In any case, a lower StatRating™ is on the cards this week, as is a sub 90 scoreboard result.

It's hard to fault Port's recent form over the last 3 weeks, but they may have had their "low" last week against Collingwood. After 2 consecutive games of high StatRating™ Margins, they came closer on the stats sheet as expected, but still managed a decent score. The last 3 weeks have been against 2 bottom sides, and a struggling Melbourne, so those margins are to be expected. The 37 point margin could have been close had the Magpies kicked straight, but apart from the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter, they were never in doubt. It was a steady, workman like win, and similar figures from past games have been tabled below to indicate what their performance might be like this week.

The figures highlighted in light blue represent current playing criteria, while the figures in red show the game result in the following week, and the cells highlighted in Green indicate Port's StatRating™ in the following week. The bottom figures show Port Adelaide's latest form. There a 5 games which match this current playing level, with 4 wins and a loss resulting. Their StatRating™ in the following week has been good, with the 313 registered against Stkilda at York Park better than it looks. Their StatRating™ Margin has always been positive in the following week, and they have restricted the Opposition StatRating™ to an average of an impressive 281. They lost to Adelaide in the showdown earlier in the year after registering 2 high StatRating™ results in the previous games, but don't have that problem this week.

Interesting figures for the Crows here, as they have lost 5 of their 11 home games this year. That figure was 4 last year and only 3 in 2002. Where they have only had Collingwood kick over 100 against them previously, this year 4 teams have added to that stat. Subsequently, their Opposition StatRating™ and average Opposition scored have risen. They have still been able to maintain a decent score and StatRating™, but have been vulnerable here this year. They have had some decent wins, but also an 8 goal flogging by Essendon in round 8. That has been their biggest loss in the past 3 years, and is usually competitive at this ground.

Port's only loss this year was at the hands of the Crows, and they'll be keen to atone this week. Impressive figures all round from Port, with an average winning margin of 50 points. The Adelaide game was the only time they did not reach the ton on the scoreboard, while only Geelong and Adelaide have kicked 100 against them here this year. Of the 11 games played, only 4 are current Top 8 Sides.

Adelaide's Top 8 form is 3 wins and 9 losses from 12 games played. At AAMI Stadium, the figures get better and read 3-3. They are still behind averages on the scoreboard, but seem to hold their own with StatRating™ figures. They are a hit or miss when rating on the games, as they have 4 figures above 600, and the other 8 all below the 428 figure. Their current form suggests the figure won't be 600 this week.

Port's form against Top 8 sides reads well this year, as you would expect a Top 2 side to be. They have 7 wins from 9 games, with away losses to Melbourne and Brisbane accounting for their losses. They have really stamped their authority in the last 5 of these games, although the round 17 win against West Coast was fortunate, as they kicked so inaccurately. That form has certainly gone on to look good, as West Coast has won 7 of their past 8 games. The Crows are not Top 8 material, and even though they don't have any home ground advantage, Port should be able to cover the Crows here.

It is Ports comeback game this week, after 2 week on the road. Many sides can often feel the effect of travel, and so the table highlights Port's form when returning from their 2 week stint. It's meant to highlight more so if the team is affected when coming back, rather than what score they are likely to kick. As you can see, they have not had any issues in the following weeks after coming back from successive interstate trips, and if anything, have always had a very high StatRating™ Margin to follow.

## Final Summary

- Head to Head Contests are 7-2 in Port Adelaide favour since 2000.
- The Crows current form suggests they may produce an average effort, as they have 4 games this year that have seen them lose in the following week when at these levels.
- Port Adelaide had their "low" last week against Collingwood, and has played well in the past when at these current playing levels. They have a 4-1 record in the past 2 years.
- The Crows form at AAMI Stadium has slipped this year, and has only 6 wins from 11 games.
- Port Adelaide's form at AAMI Stadium is outstanding, with their only loss coming from Adelaide. They have an average winning margin of 50 points this year at AAMI Stadium.
- The Crows form against Top 8 sides is poor, with only 3 wins from 12 games. In the games played at AAMI Stadium, their record is 3-3.
- Port's form against Top 8 sides is very good, with 7 wins from 9 games.
- Port Adelaide return from 2 weeks on the road this week and history shows they have a good strike rate when coming back. Their StatRating™ Margin is usually over 200.

At the line signifies that you will be able to get a better price on Port Adelaide (\$1.90), but they will have to win by more than 17 points. In the Crows case, you will be offered a lesser price, but they will have the ability to lose by up to 17 points or even win the game, for you to collect. As long as they don't lose by 18 points or more, then you collect.

The twin peaks that the Crows have registered in the past 2 weeks may be their downfall against Port Adelaide here. All the Stats seem to point to a Port Adelaide victory, with their form at the ground being very impressive. The last game syndrome is niggling here, with Port looking at another finals campaign. They already have a long injury list, and cant afford any more with the Finals around the corner. The Showdowns are always a physical encounter, but Adelaide's StatRating™ figures suggest they may have peaked too early, ensuring Port ends up with a Top 2 spot.
